

Building Permits Issued Last Week Include One for \$30,000 Structure

Building permits dropped sharply again last week. There were only thirty for \$100 or more, and these came to a total of \$47,805. There was an average of four daily for Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Monday's permits came to \$30,480; Tuesday's dropped to \$9,200, and Wednesday's dropped to \$650. There were eleven on Thursday for a total of \$5,400, and seven Friday for \$2,025. The highest single permit was recorded Monday, for \$30,000. The following permits were recorded last week:
